

4.20.1 Optional Review lesson

Teaching Goal: This lesson is for assessment. It will help you evaluate how well your students are learning the key concepts, Bible stories and problem solving process. Most teachers will use the lesson as a game but you may ask the questions as a paper and pencil test if you wish.

Game. Divide the class into teams. Call on one person on the team to choose a category (Short answer, Memory Verse or People). Read the question and then give them a few seconds to discuss it as a team. Call on one person from the team. That person must answer. Other team members cannot answer for them. (This requires that each person listen when the team discusses the answer.) Keep score on the board.

- Short Answer (SA) – 3 points
- Memory Verse (MV) cards – 2 points
- People Cards (PC) – 1 point

Let the teams take turns until you have used all the questions.

Optional. You may want to cut the questions and answers apart. Glue the question to the front of a 3x5 card and put the answer on the back. This makes it easy to hold the questions. Make sure the students don't see the answers.
